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







Angelica Blechschmidt, the former editor-in-chief of German Vogue, always had a camera in her hand and snapped from the front row, backstage and at parties. Some of the shots used to appear in her Vogue column 'Flash!' She assembled a unique chronicle of an era at a time when street-style and backstage photography were in their infancy. Today, with digital tools, spontaneous snapshots can be edited in an instant. Yet it is the unfiltered edge of Blechschmidt's images that stands out and marks them as typically 1990s.



In the 1990s backstage photos took on an artistic and commercial value of their own. Inspirations from behind the scenes found their way into campaigns and editorials, as did Helmut Newton's photo for Italian *Vogue* and Roxanne Lowit's Dior campaign. Both depict the process of dressing – the preparation for a fashion show or a photo shoot that is normally hidden from the eyes of audiences or magazine readers. The prominent, public status of these pictures reflects the desire for authenticity that developed in the 1990s.
