If your piece is on a picture, say the name of the pet.


Then move your piece to the written word.

If your piece is on a word, read it aloud. Then move your piece to the correct picture.


If your piece is on "Miss a turn." you are not allowed to throw the dice in the next round.

The child that gets to the flag first is the winner!











