

Thomas, the dad, has got black hair. He is wearing an orange pullover with blue jeans and brown shoes.


Anne has got blonde hair. She is wearing her new purple dress with pink shoes.

Number 5: It is a bird. It has feathers. It is not a pet. It lives on the farm. [rooster]










2. Listen and number  $\frac{1}{3}$  the vegetables.
