

## Trouble with the teacher (teacher, student)

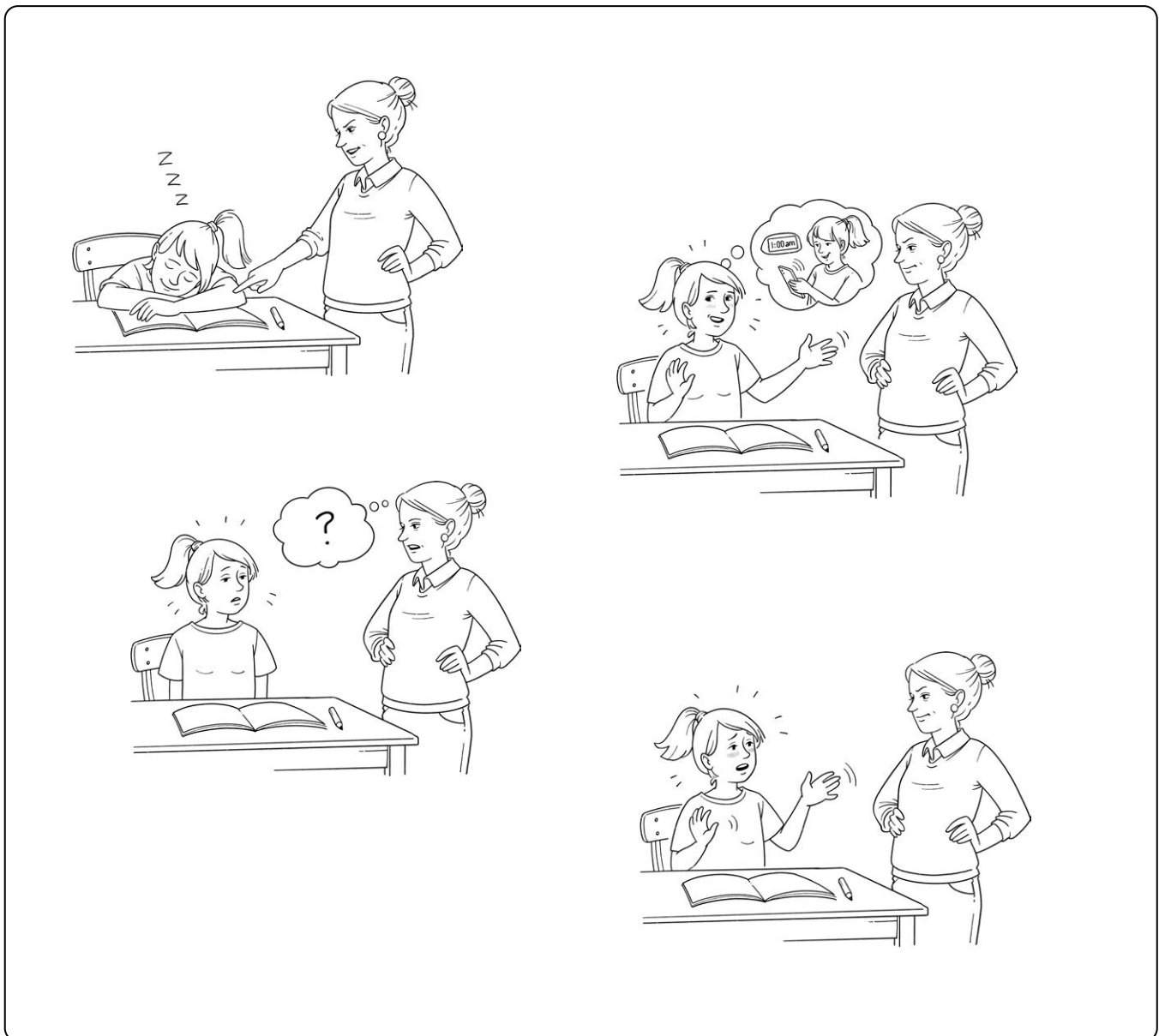
### Situation:
